Center Fielders News "Watching, A Vital Necessity"

"Be on guard! Be alert! You do not know when that time will come." These were the words of Jesus spoken in Mark 13:33. When weather conditions are right for tornado activity, the weather station broadcasts a tornado watch. This tells people to go ahead with their activities but be alert for severe weather. The station issues a tornado warning if a tornado has actually been spotted. The verse above is somewhat like a tornado watch. Jesus described some conditions and events that shall come to pass as the time of His coming approaches.

In ancient times, people built walls of protection around their cities. Towers were placed at intervals on the walls, where watchmen were stationed to look out for approaching danger. Habakkuk was a watchman in a spiritual sense. He wrote, "I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what God will say to me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved" (Habakkuk 2:1). This is some great advice for us all in our daily Christian walk.

Inadequate watching contributed to the sinking of the Titanic. There were several pair of binoculars on the ship, stored under lock and key, but the officer in charge of them was transferred off the ship just before the voyage. He forgot to give the key to the officer who replaced him, so the lookout on the Titanic had to watch with unaided eyes. He testified later that the binoculars might have helped others to spot the iceberg soon enough to avoid it. As poor watching led to great natural loss, so will neglecting to watch for Christ lead to eternal loss. Be on guard! Be alert! These are the words of Jesus, not Rodney!



THE BIG BANG
