Míke's Mínute

Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed.

James 5:16

Admitting you are struggling with a sin is always the first step to overcoming it. What is hidden is destined to remain in darkness, but confessing sin exposes it to the light.

In the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector, the Pharisee points to his own righteousness, while the tax collector confesses his sin (Luke 18:9-14). It is the tax collector that Jesus commends for his humility.

Just putting our sins into words often removes the power they hold over us. Name it and nail it!

The second step, as outlined by James, completes the process. When we follow up an initial confession with prayer, we receive divine help that can lead us to victory over sins that once held us in bondage. And when we seek the prayers of godly believers, our opportunity for victory increases.

Regardless of your past record, you do not need to be defeated by sin's pull or power again. You can request the prayers of a trusted friend, Christian counselor, or elder of the church.

Today is the day to take the first step toward spiritual healing. It begins in confession and sounds something like this...

Lord, I confess that I am a sinner...


