Making restitution is a wonderful privilege. In a sense, it allows us to change the past.

While we can never turn back the clock, we sometimes have an opportunity to correct past mistakes... to take a past wrong and make it right.

When the opportunity presents itself, we should take full advantage. If we have taken, we can return. If we have broken, we can fix. If we have hurt, we can apologize and attempt to heal.

The 8th and 9th steps in Alcoholics Anonymous is about restitution. Recovering addicts are encouraged to make a list of all people they have harmed and become willing to make amends to them all.

Zacchaeus was a small man with some big mistakes in his past. When he met Jesus, he decided to do what he could to get past his past. Part of this process was restitution.

We cannot undo what we did. We cannot "unscramble eggs." Some things in our past are impossible to fix. But that shouldn't stop us from looking for ways to make amends for wrongs we have done.

Restitution is solid evidence of Christ's life-changing power in our lives.
