There were various people in the Bible who wanted to associate with other people of God.

Ruth desired to be part of God’s people in Israel, so she left her Moabite country and went with Naomi.

In Acts, after Peter and John were apprehended by the Jewish leaders, they were released again. “And on their release, Peter and John went back to their own people,” (verse 23). They knew where their company was.

In Acts 12, after an angel delivered Peter from prison, he immediately went to the house where fellow believers were praying.

Jesus taught in Matthew 18 that believers should work together to help each other. If possible, we should be part of an established New Testament church family to do that. The church is the body of Christ, and if we are baptized into Christ, we are members of His Body. “For we were all baptized by one Spirit into one body, whether Jews or Gentiles slave or free, and we are all given one Spirit to drink” (1 Corinthians 12:13).

There are faithful believers in many nations throughout the world, but they are all part of His church. 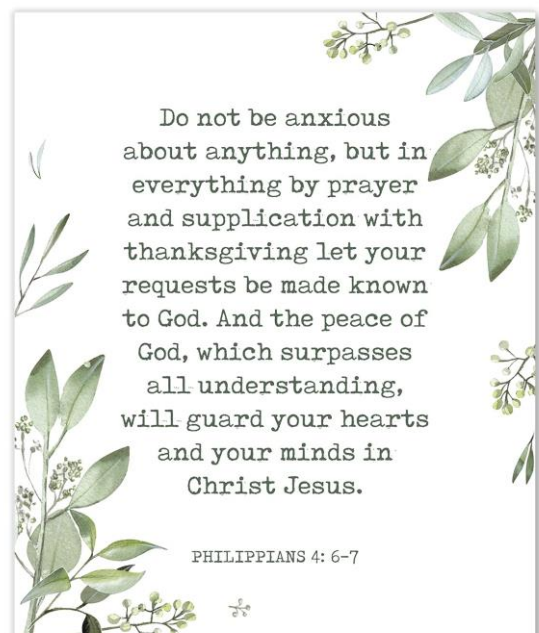
