Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:1

The American Heritage Dictionary defines faith as (among other things) "belief that does not rest on logical proof or material evidence."

Is Christianity illogical, or is there material evidence for our faith? We, of course, assert that our faith *is* logical and based on material evidence.

To name one example, we were not present at the resurrection nor did we see the empty tomb of Jesus. However, people did see the empty tomb and more than 500 people saw the resurrected Jesus. So, yes, there is material evidence for our faith.

But, we do admit that the Christian life is based on what is unseen rather than what is seen. So, how do we strengthen our faith?

We read and take to heart the promises of God. His "exceeding great and precious promises" are the basis of us partaking in His "divine nature" (2 Peter 1:4).

Faith in promises not based on evidence is blind faith. Faith in promises based on evidence is biblical faith.

Instead of just *sitting on the premises,* let's start *standing on the promises* of God... and watch our faith soar!
