Míke's Mínute

As he (Jesus) was passing by, he saw a man blind from birth. His disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" "Neither this man nor his parents sinned," Jesus answered. "This came about so that God's works might be displayed in him."

John 9:1-3

In John 9, Jesus and his disciples encountered a man who had been blind from birth. People, including the disciples, falsely assumed that the blindness was a punishment for sin.

Jesus sets the record straight by revealing the real reason for the man's blindness... "This came about so that God's works might be displayed in him."

Sometimes the purpose of prayer is to *get us out* of circumstances, but more often than not, the purpose of prayer is to *get us through* them.

We are often so fixated on *getting out* of a difficult, painful or challenging situation that we fail to *get anything out* of the situation! We fail to learn the lessons that God is trying to teach us or to cultivate the character God is trying to grow in us. We are so focused on God changing our circumstances that we never allow God to change us!

God doesn't want us to just *go* through pain. He wants us to *grow* through pain.

Sometimes we need to pray "get me out" prayers. But sometimes we need to pray "get me through" prayers. And we always need to be praying for the wisdom and discernment to know when to pray for what.

Can God change our circumstances? Absolutely! But when our circumstances don't change, it's often an indication that it is *us* that God is trying to change. Either way, the chief objective of prayer (and life) is to glorify God in any and every situation.
