Míke's Mínute

"The most important one (commandment)," answered Jesus, "is this: 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord, our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord, your God, with all your heart..."

Mark 12:29-30

The term "heart" is used in the Bible in many different ways. It can refer to a person's intellect, or to his will. In the context of Mark 12, however, it refers to the seat of the emotions... the center of feelings. Jesus tells us to love God with our emotions.

Sometimes we underestimate the importance of emotions in religion. Likely, we have reacted to the emotionalism so prevalent in many religions today.

While we do not want to overemphasize the place of emotions, we would be wrong to seek to eliminate them from our religious experience.

In David Roper's *Truth for Today Commentary* on this verse, he compares emotions to the motor of a car. The word *emotion* and *motor* are related words. He says that emotions are like the motor of a car. The mind is like the steering wheel. It takes *both* for a car to reach its destination.

A car with a good motor and no steering wheel might go fast but where would it end up? A car with a functional steering wheel but no motor would go nowhere at all. A car needs both.

Emotions motivate us to love and serve God. They *drive* us. Our minds *steer* us to use our motivation to love and serve in ways that are guided by God.

Let your emotions be your motor. Let your mind be your steering wheel. Love God with your heart and mind.

"He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness."

- 2 Corinthians 9:10 (ESV)

This verse is a great reminder that everything we have—our resources, time, talents, even the desire to do good and help others—comes from God. He's the one who gives us the "seed," and He's also the one who makes it grow.

Paul was writing to the church in Corinth to encourage them in their generosity. He wanted them to know that when we give, especially to meet the needs of others, we're giving from a place of trust. It's about growing in righteousness, in love, in kindness. So, whether you're giving your time, your finances, or simply offering a helping hand, remember that God is at work through your generosity. You're planting seeds that He promises to grow. And we know that God always makes good on His promises!
